There is an inseparable link between what happens here at Emerald Hills and what happens in the lives of our

team members living overseas. Here's just one tiny example: In June, we assembled a 6-person team here to visit the tsunamistricken area of northeastern Japan. While there in Ishinomaki, our visiting team members were able to see firsthand the devastation wrought by the powerful waves. Our hosts were so busy with the reconstruction and the hands-on ministry, so we asked them to give us the bullet points of their next-step goals. Upon completion of our trip, we

returned to Emerald Hills and fashioned a grant request to I.D.E.S. (International Disasters Emergency Services), a funding partner that had helped us with disaster relief at

times in the past. Last week, from our offices here at Emerald Hills, we were able to call the field team to inform

them that I.D.E.S. had granted every facet of our request. They sent a check for \$175,625 to empower the Ishinomaki team to tackle the half-dozen ministry areas we described.

When our team here at International Services gathered in the Prayer Center and Atrium to give thanks to God for the muchneeded help, a visiting team from Southeast Asia commented, "Doug, this must be one of the best parts of your job - being able to call people with this kind of news." Actually, there are MANY "best

parts" of my job, and one of them is understanding the connection between Emerald Hills and our field teams. It is inseparable.
